








I have symptoms of COVID-19


Begin isolating immediately. You should not come to campus.







I had close contact with someone who has COVID-19 or who is suspected of having COVID-19




- Wear a high-quality mask or respirator (e.g., N95) any time you are around others in your home or in public and in ALL SETTINGS ON UIC'S CAMPUS through day 10 from your exposure date.
- Monitor yourself for symptoms of COVID-19 for 10 days from exposure
 - If you <u>develop symptoms</u>

- Wear a high-quality mask or respirator (e.g., N95) any time you are around others in your home or in public and in ALL SETTINGS ON UIC'S CAMPUS through day 10 from your exposure date.
- PCR test no sooner than 5 days after you are exposed
 - If you <u>test positive</u>
- Monitor yourself for symptoms of COVID-19 for 10 days from exposure
 - If you <u>develop symptoms</u>
