Students in all online programs pay an additional Library and Information Technology Assessment of \$18 per credit hour. There are no additional Out of State charges or student fees for online programs.

- 1. In order to generate resources to improve the learning environment, a Library and Information Technology Assessment is assessed to all students.
- 2. Properly admitted International students are assessed the international student fee which is \$130 in fall and spring; \$65 summer. The University has approved an international student fee for all international students attending UIC. The fee will allow the Office of International Services to continue to provide essential services, upgrade technologies used for student advising, increase programming options, and host cultural events to increase and expand upon the "UIC Experience." In addition, all incoming international students are charged an Orientation/Arrival Fee to cover the costs of initial arrival services and programs.
- 3. Students registered for Zero hours in an online program will be assessed at the 1 hour per credit hour rate.
